

Funding Breakdown

Daines announced that \$1,820,929 will be directed towards supporting disabled adults and Montana public housing during the Coronavirus pandemic through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

\$875,012 will be directed through Mainstream Vouchers, which are tenant-based vouchers that serve households that include a non-elderly person with a disability.

\$945,917 will be directed through the Supplemental Public Housing Operating Funds to prevent, prepare, and respond to the Coronavirus Pandemic in public housing.
