

Department of Transportation Grant Releases 06.24.2019

The \$8,019,366 will be disbursed for the following counties:

- \$200,000.00 for the Montana Aeronautics Division in Gallatin County
 - This grant will provide federal funding for the Yellowstone Airport associated with West Yellowstone, Montana.
 - This project conducts an environmental study to evaluate any potential environmental impacts related to the construction of a new terminal building.
- \$243,000.00 for the County of Pondera

 - This project rehabilitates 21,750 square yards of the existing general aviation apron to maintain the structural integrity of the pavement.

 - This project rehabilitates the electrical vault serving the existing Runway 12/30 lighting system that has reached the end of its useful life and requires rehabilitation to enhance safe airfield operations during low visibility conditions.

 - This grant will provide federal funding for the Helena Regional Airport associated with Helena, Montana.
 - This project rehabilitates 9,000 feet of the existing Runway 9/27 pavement that has reached the end of its useful life.
